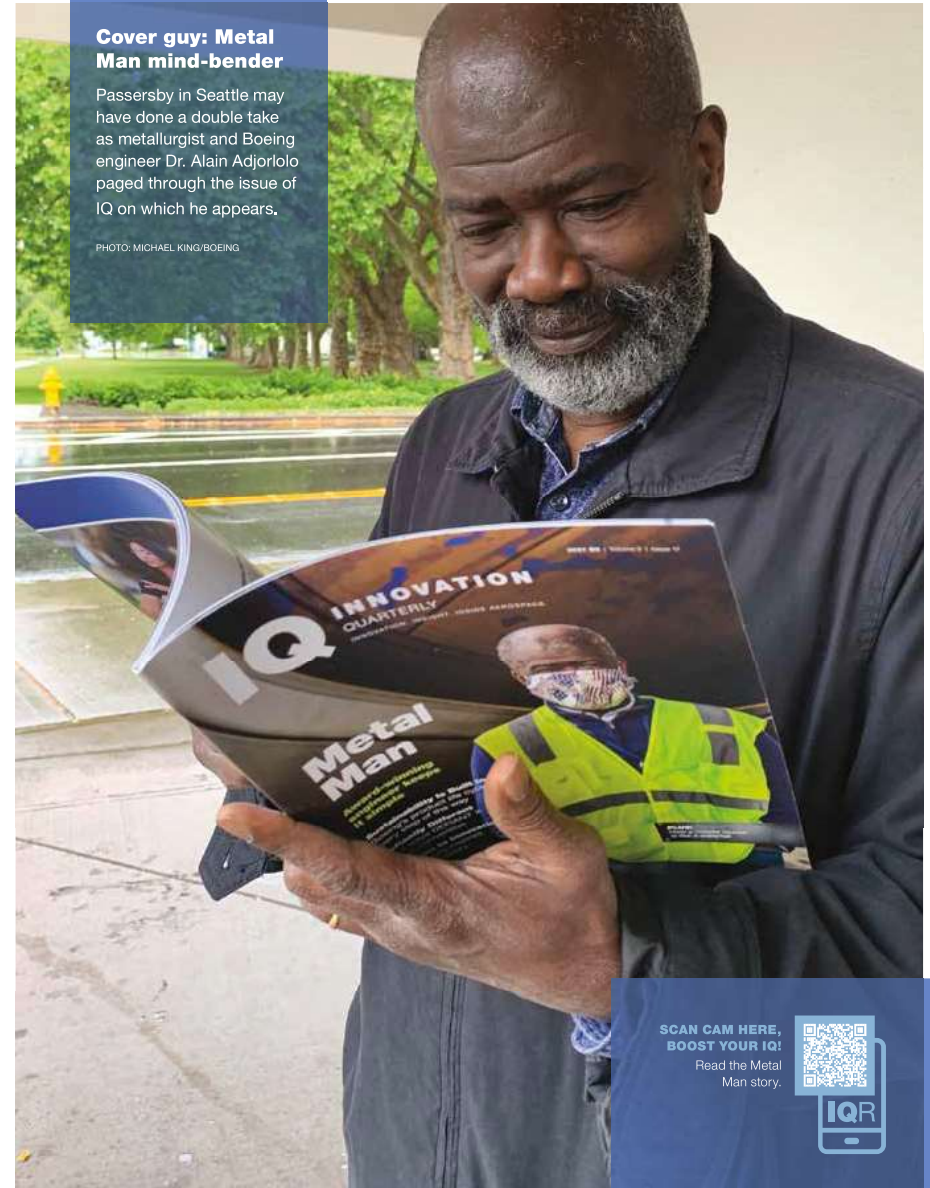
Gwen Lighter, GoFly CEO, said the organizers look forward to going even bigger.
